Pre-Kindergarten: Four days a week in person, with transportation provided for those that request

Elementary (Grades K - 5): Five days a week face-to-face instruction

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Five days a week face-to-face instruction

High School (Grades 9 - 12): Five days a week face-to-face instruction

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

Currently the district does not have any English Language learners requesting remote instruction. We do have some special education students requesting a blended option or fully online.

Document Public Comments:

Parents have expressed concerns for the amount of time their child is spending wearing a mask during the school day and at athletic events. Parents have requested it be a students option.

Reconfirmation Meeting for November/ December 2020

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level: Face to face instruction 5 days a week for all grades if allowed per executive orders
Pre-Kindergarten: Face to face
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Face to face
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Face to face
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Face to face if allowed per executive orders
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
Special populations of students will be provided services face to face as allowed - priority will be given for those students with specialized plans to receive in person instructions
Document Public Comments:
Public states would like high school students to be allowed to return to the school environment. Since the district is allowing for Junior High instruction they believe

High School students should be given the same benefit. While teachers are trying, virtual learning is not optimal.
